4-H ARCHERY MEMBERS Only

Lemoore 4-H Invitational

Open to any Active 4-H member enrolled in a 4-H Archery Shooting Sports Project

Entry Fee: \$10 per person/per class \$15.00 for both

(will include a one day pass to the Kings Fair to receive your medal)

Passes must be picked-up by July 1st 2010

Entrants may enter one class max.

(Proceeds pay for targets and awards)

All entries need to bring their own bow and arrows.

**ALL ENTRANTS MUST BE VERIFIED AS BEING CURRENTLY ENROLLED IN
4-H Archery Project BY YOUR LOCAL UCCE OFFICE. Only parents of 4-H members or 4-H Leaders can
participate in the adult shoot or with approval of Range Master. Each member and
Adult shooter must have a release of liability form on site the day of the shoot.**

1. Juniors will shoot at 15 yards (9-10 years)
2. Intermediates will shoot at 15 yards (11-13 years)
3. Seniors will shoot at 15 yards (14-18 years)

4. Adults will shoot at 20 yards (not telling) "Fun Shoot"

The target to be used will be the 40cm colored target. These targets are scored 1-10 plus the X ring. Any shot outside of the ring will be a zero.

The match will consist of 10 ROUNDS- 3 shots per round totaling 30 shots. There will be a 3 minute time frame per round.

Arrow must break target. If an arrow breaks the line, shooter receives the next highest score. **If shooter shoots more than 3 arrows that round will not be scored.** If there is a cross fire, shooter will lose the score for that arrow. Any arrow dropped within one (1) yard may not be picked up until the **Range Master** stops the line and clock. After line is safe, shooter may shoot the arrow. If arrow is dropped further than one (1) yard from the shooting line, shooter may not retrieve this arrow to shoot. Shooter loses that shot (no score).

Shooting line will be straddled at each distance. The safety line will only be crossed by the shooters who are called forward to shoot. Bows will be place on the bow rack behind line with arrows in a quiver or suitable storage.

There will be no talking between safety and shooting lines. Shooters may address questions to the RANGE MASTER as needed.

VOICE COMMANDS

Voice Commands: Archers to the shooting line: nock your arrow: Begin Shooting: Cease Fire: Stop Shooting **IMMEDIATELY!!** Put arrows in quiver

After Voice commands: There is no coaching or talking on the shooting line. All problems will be addressed to the Range Master. Two warnings for Misconduct, such as talking on the line, stepping over lines, or not following commands, any other safety violations such as pointing a knocked arrow toward another shooter would be an example of misconduct. Practice rounds will be allowed at specified times. In the Fair / Invitational Archery Match, there will be 2 judges that will pull the arrows and write down scores on the score sheets.

AWARDS

1st- 3rd place medal for each class will be given and a Trophy for overall high point winner, at the Kings County Awards Breakfast July 11, 2010, 8a.m. at the Kings Fair Grounds. **(Breakfast is not free and must attend to receive your medal)**

Breakdown of Shooting Categories:

Compound:

Class 1: fingers only, without sights, no counterbalance

Class 2: freestyle-release, sights ,with or without counterbalance

Recurve:

Class 3: freestyle- with sights, with or without counterbalance

Class 4: traditional- no additions (string knock ok)

Longbow

Class 5: bare bow - no sights, counterbalance etc. (string knock ok)

DIVISION 950 - JUNIORS (9-10 YRS. OLD)

DIVISION 951 - INTERMEDIATE (11-13 YRS. OLD)

DIVISION 952 - SENIORS (14-18 YRS. OLD)

ALL 4-H MEMBERS ARE INVITED TO ATTEND

ADULT SHOOT AFTER MATCH

Only parents of 4-H members or Adult 4-H Leaders can participate in the **“Fun Shoot”** this shoot will start after all the 4-H members have finished shooting. **Entry fee for the adult shoot is \$10 per person.** (proceeds will support the Lemoore 4-H archery groups) **Bring your own bow and arrows.** Each parent of adult leader planning on shooting, must have a medical release form, and money by the day of the match.
