RULES:

1. All entries must have been completed within the last **TWO YEARS** and not previously exhibited at The Kings Fair. Entries limited to residents of Fresno, Kings and Tulare Counties unless otherwise specified.
2. List only fine art and photography entries on the Department Entry form. Fine Art and Photography are listed as one department. For example, you can enter a painting and a photograph on the same sheet, not any home arts or floriculture. You will need another entry form for those departments.
3. All works (fine art and photography) **MUST BE TITLED** to identify the item incase a tag falls off exhibit item. Please have your name on the back of your entry too. Exhibitor is limited to two entries per class unless otherwise specified.
4. **PHOTOGRAPHY:** All entries **MUST BE AN 8X10 PHOTOGRAPH AND MATTED ON AN 11x14 PICTURE MATT. NO FRAMES, HOOKS, WIRES, STRING OR TAPE.** Exhibitor is limited to two entries per class unless otherwise specified.

5. **FINE ART:** Exhibit **MUST** have proper hardware for hanging (wires and hooks) or exhibit cannot be judged. All fine art must be framed unless your work on canvas is a box frame that doesn't require framing. (Adult -Divisions 100P-115D and Junior, Boy & Girl Scouts fine art. Classes 120 - 134). Exhibitor is limited to two entries per class unless otherwise specified.
6. Each artist may set a price for each entry if wishing to sell. All inquires regarding sale of entries will be referred directly to the exhibitor to complete the sale.
7. The Kings Fair reserves the right to exclude an entry which is not in the best interest of the fair, and reserves the right to disqualify any exhibitor(s) who conducts themselves in an inappropriate manner, without discussion or justification. No payment of any awards will be made to individuals so disqualified.
8. Entries are at the exhibitor's own risk. Utmost care will be given to all entries; however, The Kings Fair accepts no responsibility for loss, stolen or damage of any kind to any entry. There is security in the building during exhibit hours. Your signature on the entry form is acceptance of this rule.

DEFINITIONS

AMATEUR: An amateur may have won up to five (5) blue ribbons at previous Kings Fair art or photography competitions.

INTERMEDIATE: An intermediate exhibitor is one who has won between six (6) and ten (10) Blue Ribbons at previous Kings Fair art or photography competitions

ADVANCED: An advanced exhibitor is one who has won between eleven (11) and fifteen (15) blue ribbons at previous Kings Fair art or photography competitions.

ACCOMPLISHED: An accomplished exhibitor is one who has won sixteen (16) or more blue ribbons at previous Kings Fair art or photography competitions.

BEST OF SHOW: The current winner of Best of Show must move to the next level of competition the following year (i.e: if the winner of Best of Show is competing as an amateur this year,

he/she must enter as intermediate the following year).

JUNIOR: All junior exhibitor age is determined by the year entry has been completed. (i.e., If exhibitor turns 18 years old before Kings Fair, they are still eligible for the junior division.)
